






ICPDR coordinates implementation of EU Water Framework Directive & EU Floods Directive

Suggestions & key messages



- Transboundary cooperation in river basins is essential ("shared waters, joint responsibilty")
- Empower **national stakeholders**, e.g. national authorities
- Align cooperation efforts with existing frameworks (UNECE, EU, Ramsar, bi-lateral agreements, etc.)
- Identify strong individuals e.g. civil society actors & create ongoing processes to "cultivate" this grassroot level (e.g. Danube Art Master)
