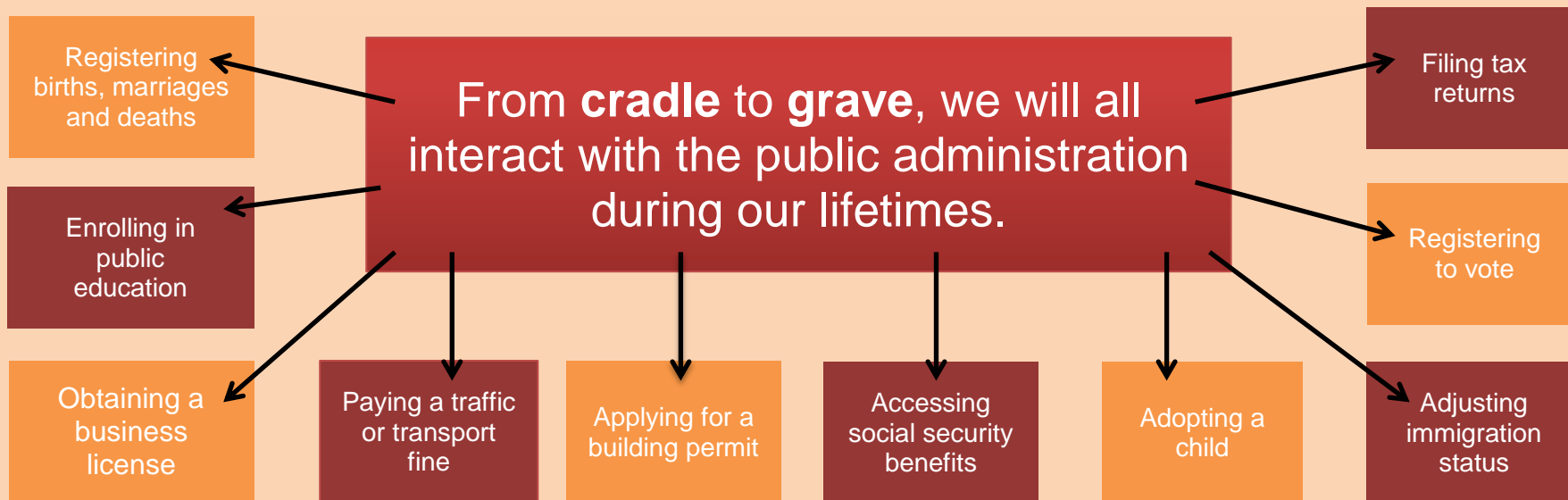


Why monitor administrative justice?



Because of the **impact** of administrative acts on daily life, it's **important** to have the **right to appeal** administrative decisions that affect our **rights, liberties or interests**.

When authorities make **unfair** decisions or implement decisions in a **discriminatory** manner, an effective means of redress is essential to a society based on the **rule of law**



Filing an appeal before an administrative court can provide **effective redress** if parties receive a **fair hearing**.
How can we ensure a fair hearing?
