



Government cost-sharing rose from 4% in 2010 to 50% in 2015

Local development	56 projects	\$9,170,750	50%	50%
Democratic Governance	51 projects	\$9,801,960	76%	24%

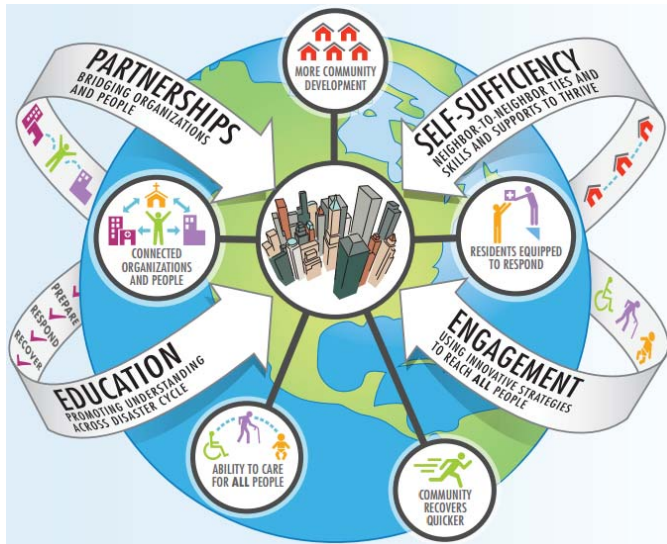
**Top Donors**

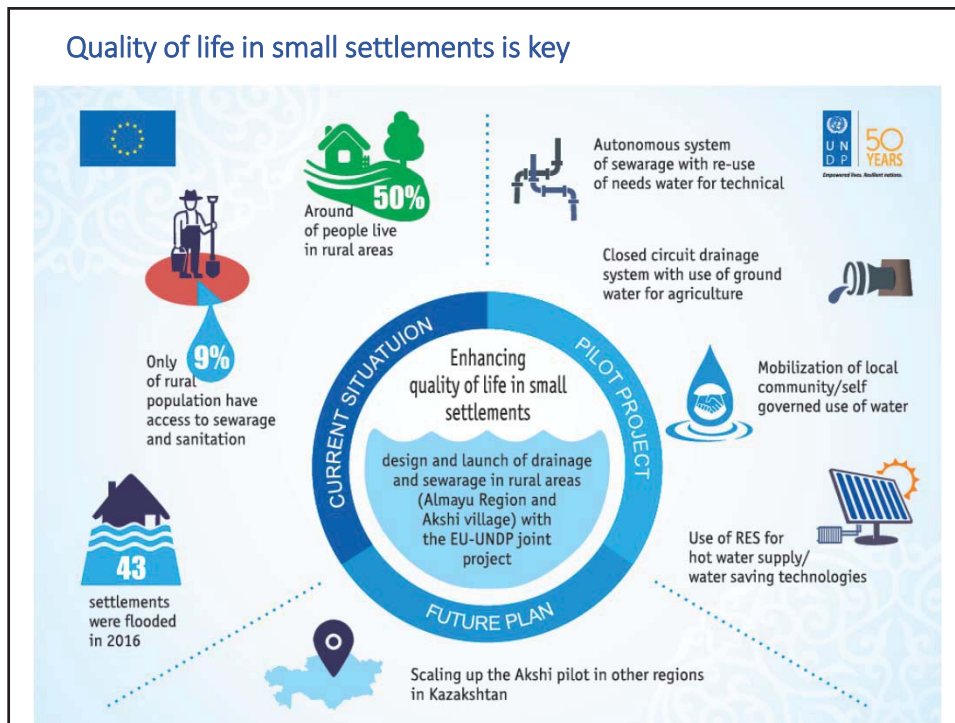

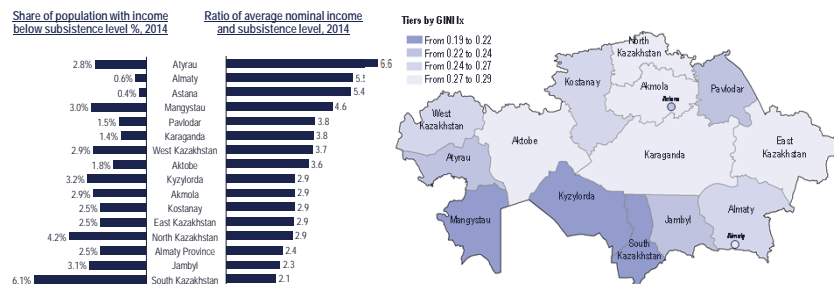
