Mr. Chairman, Ladies and Gentleman,

As a representative of an organization for a new generation of Muslims in Austria: The Muslim youth Austria.

I want to point out the fact that the legal recognition of Islam in Austria is more than the basis for a peaceful and constructive cooperation.
