

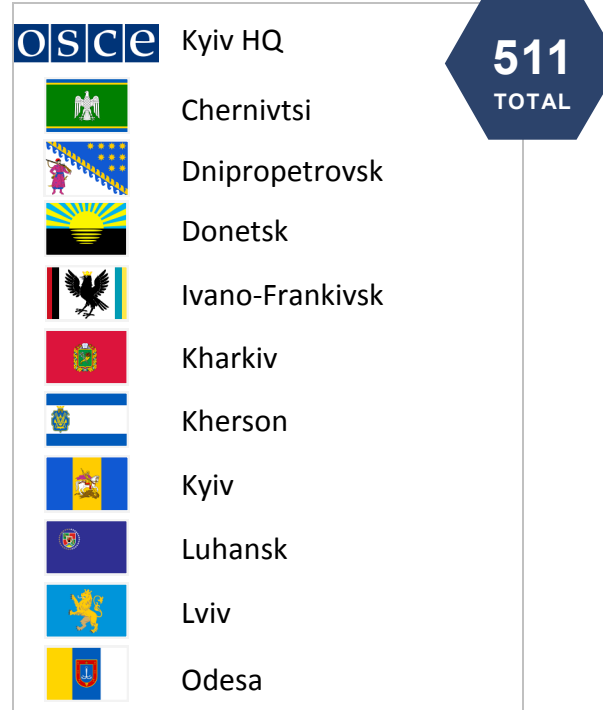


The Chief Monitor Ambassador Ertugrul Apakan visited Kramatorsk and Severodonetsk

ACTIVITIES

- The Chief Monitor Ambassador Ertugrul Apakan visited Kramatorsk and Severodonetsk on 21 and 22 November. He met with the Luhansk Regional Governor.
- The SMM facilitated a temporary ceasefire in Trokhizbenka in order for humanitarian aid to be delivered for local residents and to allow engineers in to make repairs on water and electricity supplies.
- The SMM DCM Alexander Hug took part in panel discussion “Is There Anything Left of the Minsk Agreements” in the European Parliament in Strasbourg.
- A rocket-propelled grenade and multiple anti-aircraft rounds were fired at an SMM patrol on 26 November.
- The mission continues to expand. The total number of Seconded Monitors is 341 with 158 Monitors in Donetsk and Luhansk regions.
