DECISION No. 339 ESTABLISHMENT OF AN OSCE FIELD OFFICE IN OSH, KYRGYZSTAN

The Permanent Council,

Recalling its Decision No. 245 of 23 July 1998 and with the aim of facilitating the ability of the OSCE Centre in Bishkek to implement its mandate as well as to cover the southern part of the country,

Taking note of the proposal made by the Head of the OSCE Centre in Bishkek to open an OSCE Field Office in Osh, Kyrgyzstan,

- Decides to establish an OSCE Field Office in Osh, Kyrgyzstan; and
- Approves a supplementary budget in the amount of EUR 231,900 for that purpose, as agreed on and presented in the Annex. The supplementary budget covers the period 10 February 2000 to 31 December 2000 and will be implemented in accordance with the proposal circulated by the Secretary General on 1 February 2000 (PC.IFC/9/00 Restr.).
