


ESSAY CONTEST ON THE ASSEMBLY OF KOSOVO

RULES

- 1. Each school will nominate one essay following an internal competition open to all students.
- 2. Essay will have maximum 750 words and can be written in any of the official languages.
- 3. The title page should include only the following information:
- the author's full name
- the teacher's name
- the name, address, postal code and phone number of the school
- the name, address, postal code and phone number of the author's parent/s.
- 4. Language of the essays must be tolerant, measured and respectful of diversity.
- 5. Essays will be judged on:
- content (knowledge of the subject matter)
- originality
- organization
- vocabulary (appropriate word choices)
- presentation (neatness).
