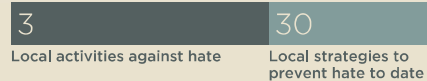

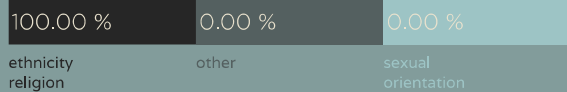

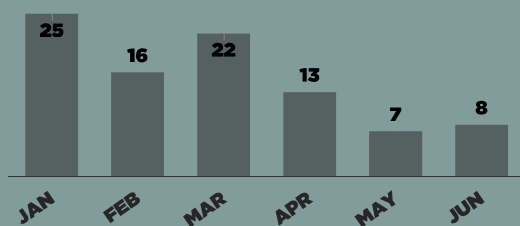

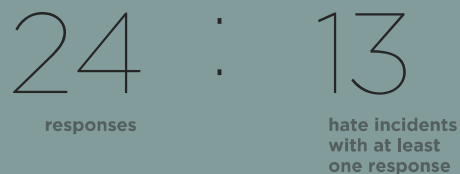
VICTIM CHARACTERISTICS:

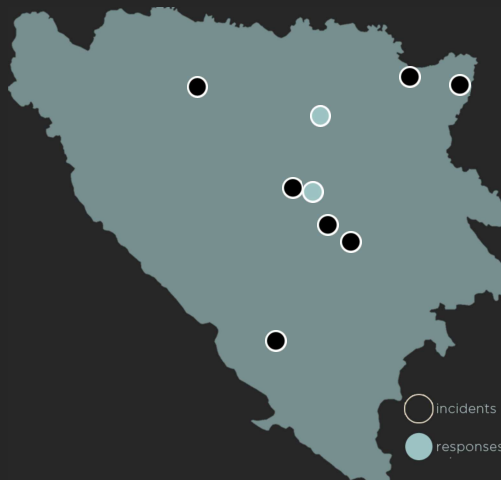
