The Nuija Model

- What the model means in practice?
- · Further training for both authorities
- · Sharing equipment, databases and facilities
- · Common briefing in the beginning of each shift
- Customs perform passport checks in cargo terminals
- Border Guards perform customs control tasks in passenger terminals
- Border Guards perform checks of invoices and tax free cheques, insurances of the vehicles and animals
- · Joint teams and responsibilities

The Nuija Model

- Innovative distribution of tasks between Customs and Border Guard
- Pilot Project operational since 5.1.2010
- Verified in Schengen Evaluation in 2011
- Phase II introduced at 1.12.2012
- Expansion of the model to other BCPs in 2014
- · Legal base is still under the development process


