OSCE donors pledged more than 10 million euros for economy in Georgia/South Ossetia

BRUSSELS, 14 June 2006 – An OSCE Donor Conference on Economic Rehabilitation in the zone of the Georgian – South-Ossetian conflict took place in Brussels, at the initiative of the Belgian OSCE Chairmanship. This conference was opened by the Chairman-in-Office, Minister Karel De Gucht. Georgian Prime Minister Zurab Nogaideli addressed the meeting. The donor conference raised an equivalent of more than 10 million euro in support of a package of projects for social and economic rehabilitation of the region, on which all parties have agreed.
