DECISION No. 902 INTERNATIONAL EXPERT WORKSHOP ON COMBATING MODERN SLAVERY: NATIONAL, REGIONAL, INTERNATIONAL EXPERIENCES

Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia, 9 and 10 February 2010

The Permanent Council,

Welcoming the proposal by Kazakhstan and Mongolia, contained in PC.DEL/836/09/Rev.1, to use the OSCE Partnership Fund to finance an international expert workshop on combating modern slavery: national, regional, international experiences, to be sponsored by the 2010 OSCE Chairmanship, in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia, on 9 and 10 February 2010,

Welcoming the sponsorship by the incoming 2010 OSCE Chairmanship of this particular event,

Recalling the Madrid Ministerial Declaration on the OSCE Partners for Co-operation (MC.DOC/1/07),

Recalling Ministerial Council Decision No. 2/03, adopted in Maastricht, on combating trafficking in human beings,

Recalling Permanent Council Decision No. 812 on the establishment of a Partnership Fund.

Decides to authorize the use of the Partnership Fund, subject to the availability of sufficient contributions, to finance the proposed workshop;

Encourages the participating States and the Asian Partners for Co-operation to contribute to the Partnership Fund for this purpose.
