



# Trackdéchets's levers to fight against corruption and waste trafficking

#### **Today**

- Waste management companies authorizations registered on Trackdéchets are checked
  - at registration
  - while transferring waste
- Producers have basic info to check companies' authorizations to collect their waste

#### **Tomorrow**

- Public authority controls on site and on roads will be made easier
- Alerts to prevent authorised sites to stock more waste than the capacity initially planned
- Producers' empowerment to check companies reinforced
- Actors not part of the system will be suspicious

By strengthening compliance, reducing admin and increasing transparency public authorities will have more time to focus on its core control activities and tackle waste crime more efficiently.

## Trackdéchets achievements and next steps

- 2 connected partners,
- 7 being in the connection process

300 active users

16 000 tons of waste transmitted safely for 45% of valorisation

#### Next steps

- Engage users across all industries
- Accelerate on the transparency side in collecting more data from public databases that are not opened yet
- Implementing an **efficient alert system** (internal and to users) and a **fully digitalised register**
- Opening access to public authorities
