SECURITY

TRANSPORT

Shuttle service

Privately owned and/or official Embassy cars will not be allowed to park in the security perimeter of the Conference. A free public car park is available just outside the security perimeter. Due to limited spaces, delegations are advised not to use their own vehicles.
