DECISION No. 457 EXTENSION OF THE MANDATE OF THE OSCE SPILLOVER MONITOR MISSION TO SKOPJE

The Permanent Council,

Recalling the "Modalities and Financial Implications for the CSCE Spillover Mission to Skopje" approved by the 17th Committee of Senior Officials on 6 November 1992,

Further recalling "Articles of Understanding Concerning CSCE Spillover Monitor Mission" exchanged on 7 November 1992,

Taking into account Permanent Council Decision No. 405 of 22 March 2001, as well as subsequent Permanent Council Decisions No. 414 of 7 June 2001, No. 437/Corr.1 of 6 September 2001 and No. 439 of 28 September 2001,

Recalling the Note Verbale No. O-107/71, dated 6 December 2001, in which the government of the host State, for budgetary planning purposes, informed about the plans developed in close co-operation with the Head of the Mission, for the engagement of the OSCE Spillover Monitor Mission to Skopje in 2002, based on the Framework Agreement,

Acting upon the request by the host State for extension of the existing mandate of the OSCE Spillover Monitor Mission to Skopje for the next six months, taking into account the plan and parameters contained in the said Note Verbale,

Decides to extend the mandate of the Spillover Monitor Mission to Skopje, until 30 June 2002.
